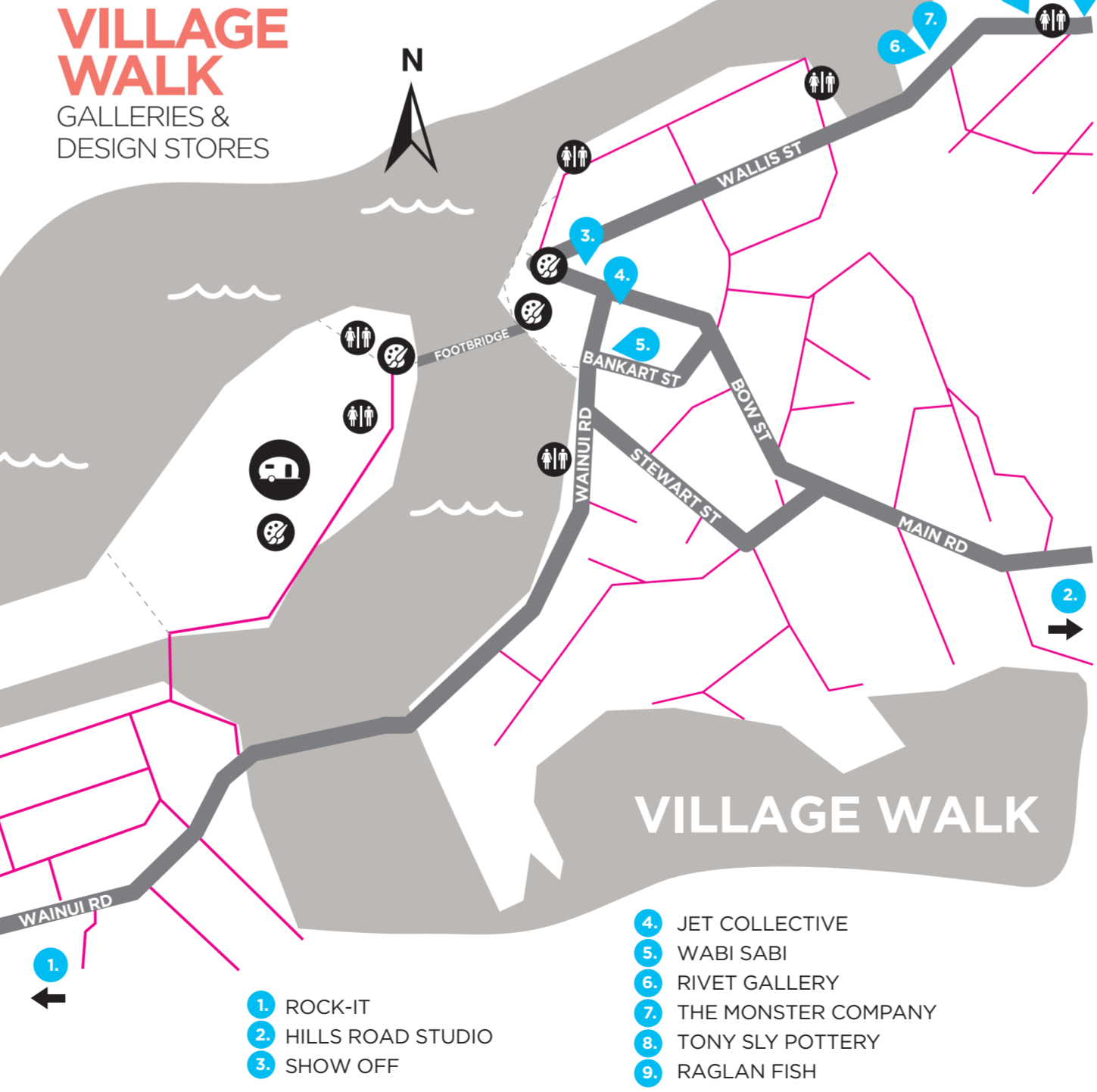

Most studios are open from 10am until 5pm, but check the artists' listings for those that close at 3pm.

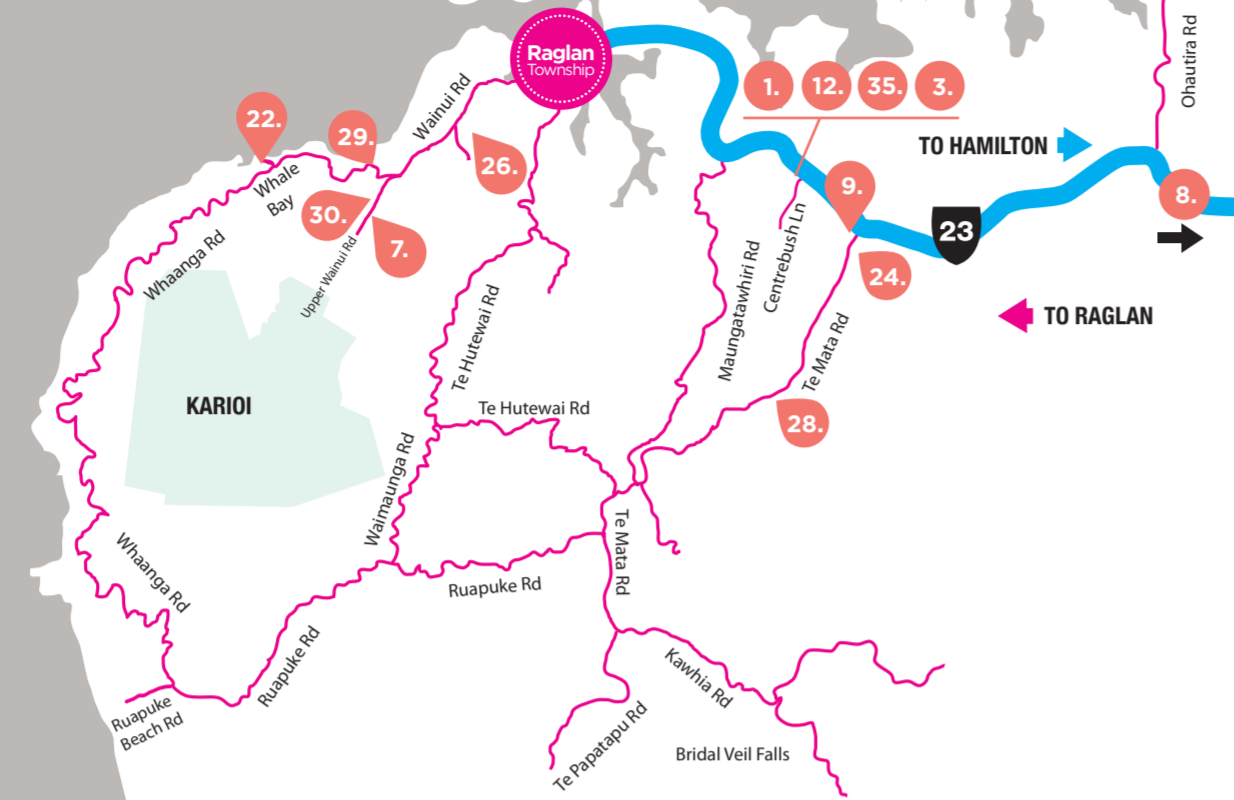
The majority are open on Monday, but a few have chosen to be open Saturday and Sunday only, so plan your routes accordingly.

At other times throughout the year, please contact artists directly to arrange a viewing.

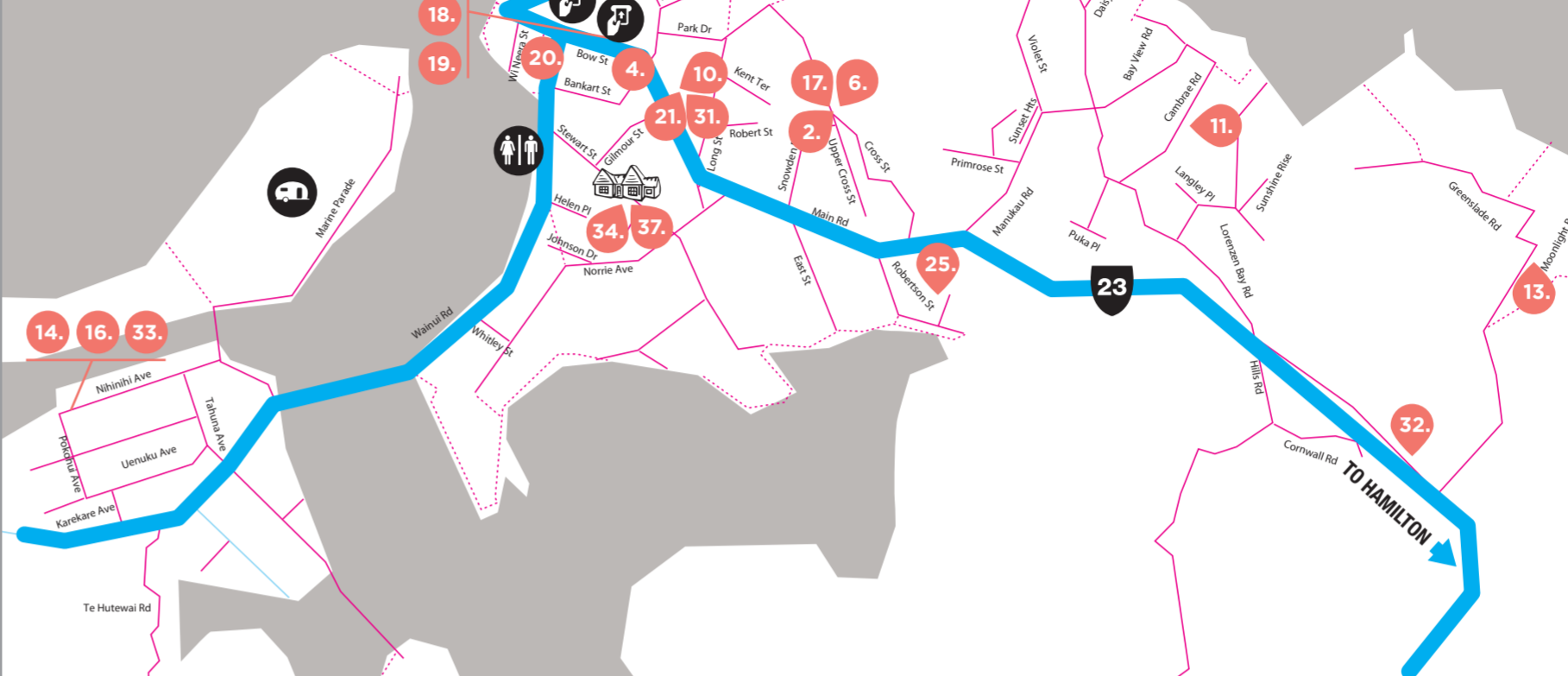
